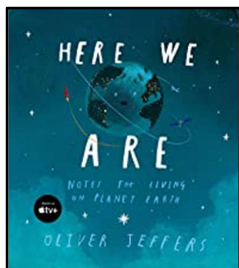

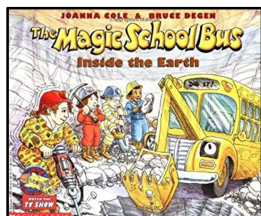
How to Make an Apple Pie and See the World

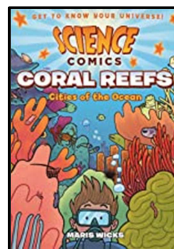

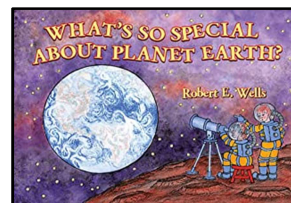
The Third Planet: Exploring the Earth from Space
